Sailing Instructions

July 4, 2024

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at the clubhouse at the Corinthian Sailing Club (CSC).

3. CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any change in the Sailing Instructions will be posted within 30 minutes of the end of the skippers meeting.

4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

4.1. Signals made ashore will be displayed from the CSC clubhouse mast.

4.2. When flag AP is displayed ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than 30 minutes after the "AP" is lowered.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

Skippers Meeting 4:30 PM

Warning signal for race 5:30 PM

One Race – Winner Takes All

Prizes Following the Race

6. CLASSES

Open to all, three of the same kind will make a class.

7. THE COURSE and MARKS

The course and marks will be posted at the clubhouse prior to the skippers meeting.

8. THE START

8.1. Races will be started using RRS 26 with the warning signal given 5 minutes before the starting signal. The starting signal for one class will be coincident with the warning signal for the next.

8.2. Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area.

9. INDIVIDUAL RECALLS

Individual Recalls will be signaled in accordance with RRS rule 29.1. In addition, the committee will attempt to hail the sail number of the offending boat(s). Failure of the over-early boat(s) to hear such notification, or the committee's failure to hail, will not be grounds for redress.

11. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

Protests will be heard July 5th at 1500 Hours at the South Sail Folding Area. Shade will not be provided. At the discretion of the PRO, arm wrestling may possibly be used to settle any protest.

12. SCORING:

The low point scoring system, Appendix A of RRS will be used except no score will be excluded. One race constitutes a regatta. Prizes will be awarded to those who best decorate their boat or wear patriotic clothing.

13. CHECK-IN

Prior to the warning signal of the race, each boat shall sail past the race committee boat and hail her sail number until acknowledged by a member of the race committee.
