Notice of Race

May 4th – 5th, 2024

Event: The Corinthian Sailing Club (Organizing Authority) cordially invites you to an open regatta for all centerboard boats and the Corinthian Class Keelboats.

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*. The Laser class rule requiring class legal sails is waived. The Flying Scot Southwest District regatta will be held in conjunction with the Commodore's Cup. To compete in the Flying Scot Southwest Districts you must be a member of [FSSA](#). You may compete as a non-member of FSSA and your score will be counted in the Commodore's Cup results, but not FS SW Districts.

Entry: Registration may be completed online at www.cscsailing.org. Late registration (after Sunday April 28th) may be completed online or at the regatta site at 441 E Lawther Drive, Dallas, TX 75218. Sailing Instructions will be available online and at check in.

Classes: Three boats of any one design will race as a class. The starting order and class flag for each class will be announced at the skippers meeting and posted.

Fees: Double handed boats advance	\$85.00
Double handed boats, after Sunday April 28 th	\$100.00
Single handed boats advance	\$50.00
Single handed boats, after Sunday April 28 th	\$65.00

* *Corinthian Sailboat (CF1) is considered a single-handed boat.*

* *Double Handed Get Two Meal Tickets, for all meals.*

* *Single Handed Get One Meal Ticket, for all meals.*

Extra Meal Tickets - \$15

Entry fee includes a CSC regatta trinket, all snack foods, beverages, and meals.

Part of the proceeds will be a donation to charity of Commodore's choice.

Courses: Windward-Leeward course will be used, planned courses are not covered by CSC Sundays SI's. SI's will have details.

Scoring: The low point scoring system, Appendix A of RRS will be used except no score will be excluded. One race constitutes a regatta.

Boat Storage: Temporary boat storage may be arranged by contacting Anderson Jones at andersonjones72@gmail.com

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 finishers in each class. In addition, each prize winner from each fleet will have their name and place of finish permanently inscribed on the Commodore's Cup Trophy, a perpetual trophy to be displayed in the Corinthian Sailing Club clubhouse on a permanent basis.

See RRS 3, The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone. By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury.
