***Notice of Race***

**October 23, 2021**

**Organizing Authority:** The Corinthian Sailing Club (CSC) is the organizing authority (OA) and is located at 441 E Lawther Drive, Dallas, TX 75218.

**Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*. Appendix C will be in effect as modified by the Sailing Instructions. SI's will be provided at check-in.

Appendix C C3 will be omitted and RRS Rule 26 will be added.

**Entry:** Each fleet (Butterfly, Corinthian, Flying Scot, Laser and Snipe) can enter one skipper, who must be a member in good standing of both the fleet and CSC. All crew must be members in good standing of CSC. Each fleet must provide the name of the skipper representing their fleet to the regatta chair by Sunday, 10/17 in order to be eligible to compete.

One or two crew may be used at the skipper's discretion. The crew member(s) may not be changed, increased or decreased during the regatta.

Each skipper must provide a deposit check of \$500 made out to Corinthian Sailing Club prior to the skipper's meeting. The deposit will be returned if no damage has occurred to the boats. All competitors must also read and sign a Liability and Waiver that will be available prior to the skipper's meeting.

**Format:** Match Racing. One round robin round is scheduled. The 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place boats from the round robin will participate in a 3 race knockout round to determine 3<sup>rd</sup> place overall, and the top two boats from the round robin will participate in a 3 race knockout round to determine the overall winner.

**Boats:** The OA will provide four Flying Scots (No Spinnaker). Competitors shall not modify boats except for temporary navigation aids and normal adjustments allowed by class rules.

Class rules requiring competitors to be members of the class association do not apply.

Competitors will notify a member of the OA of any lost or damage to equipment.

Competitors will exchange boats after each race using the boat rotation in the sailing instruction.

**Schedule:**

- **10:00 am – Skippers’ meeting at the CSC clubhouse.**
- **11:15 am – Warning signal for first race.**
- **Lunch will be provided.**
- **No races will start after 1800 Hours.**
- **Awards will be given, and snacks/drinks will be provided at the CSC clubhouse after the final race.**

**Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded to the competitors. The Maurice Martin Trophy will be awarded to the top skipper at the CSC annual banquet.

**Assumption of Risk:** By participating in this regatta, each skipper agrees to sail and to use Corinthian Sailing Club’s facilities at his or her own risk. To the fullest extent permitted under Texas law, each skipper unconditionally and irrevocably release and discharge the Corinthian Sailing Club, their officers and all other persons who lend boats or equipment, or who assist in maintaining equipment or in organizing and conducting races, from all claims and legal liability for personal injury, death or property damage incurred in connection with the regatta and caused by negligence.

**Disclaimer of Liability:** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
