

Fleet 23 Flying Scot Loaner Boat Program

Approved by the Fleet November 22, 2019

For the purpose of promoting new sailors into Corinthian Sailing Club and Fleet 23, we have boats available for short-term use.

1. FlyingScot Fleet 23 at Corinthian Sailing Club, White Rock Lake (hereinafter "FS23") has the following rules and requirements for its loaner boat program:
 - A. FS23 will provide a loaner boat subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth for the applicant;
 - B. Loaner boats are owned by FS23 and made available under the following terms and conditions to the applicant:
 1. Applicant shall fill out a form, attached, for the loaner boat program;
 2. Applicant will be limited to three (3) uses of a loaner boat per year, subject to extension by FS23;
 3. Applicant shall provide financial responsibility, consisting of a Homeowner's Policy, Renter's Policy, or some other form of liability insurance and property damage insurance for the use of the loaner boat;
 4. In the event that the applicant has no insurance applicable for the loaner boat, the applicant shall provide a \$500.00 deposit for the use of the boat, to be refunded if no damage occurs to the boat or other individuals;
 5. Applicant should be a sailor knowledgeable in the handling of a centerboard sailboat, shall have an additional crew of at least one, if not two other persons, shall provide required pfd's as required by law;
 6. Applicant shall examine the boat prior to each use with a member of FS23, preferably an officer or officer's designee, to make sure the boat is in sound condition and sound shape before using same;
 7. Applicant shall at the conclusion of the use of the boat examine it for any damage and have a member of FS23, preferably an officer or the officer's designee, examine the boat to determine whether or not any damage has been done;
 8. Applicant shall clean the boat in a good manner before putting it up, shall roll, fold or otherwise sort sails in the condition as they found them when taking the boat out.
 9. Applicant shall make sure the boat is secure in the davit with the cover attached, the plug removed and hoisted so that the rudder blade is out of the water, or alternatively, remove the rudder and put it in the boat along with the tiller;
 10. Applicant shall report any known defects to the boat to an officer of FS23 or their designee;
 11. Applicant shall be responsible for any damage caused to the loaner boat that are caused by the applicant;
 12. In the event another party is responsible for the damage, such as a port-starboard situation, applicant must identify the other party at fault, to determine that party's liability if any;
 13. No modification shall be made to the loaner boat - no holes, hardware or modification to the sails;
 14. Applicant shall sail the boat in a good seamanlike manner, without any influence of alcoholic beverages or illegal substances; and
 15. Applicant shall agree to serve on race committee at a designated time by FS23.
2. Flying Scot 23 shall:
 1. Provide a seaworthy vessel;
 2. Provide sails;
 3. Provide a slip for the boat; and
 4. Inspect and check out the boat before and after each use.
