## **Sailing Instructions**

**July 4th**

### **1. RULES**

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

### **2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS**

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at the clubhouse at the Corinthian Sailing Club (CSC).

### **3. CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Any change in the Sailing Instructions on Sunday will be posted within 30 minutes of the end of the skippers meeting.

### **4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE**

**4.1.** Signals made ashore will be displayed from the CSC clubhouse mast.

**4.2.** When flag AP is displayed ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than 30 minutes after the "AP" is lowered.

### **5. SCHEDULE OF RACES**

Sunday July 4<sup>th</sup>  
Skippers Meeting 1 PM at the Clubhouse  
First Gun 1:30 PM  
One Race - Winner Takes All  
Awards Following the Racing

### **6. CLASSES**

Open to all, three of the same kind will make a class.

## **7. THE COURSES**

- 7.1 All fleets will race on a single course.
- 7.2. Course Check Appendix 1776

Starting order will be displayed on the committee boat.

- 7.3. The diagrams in Appendix 1776 at the back of these instructions, show examples of the courses that will be used.

## **8. MARKS**

- 8.1. 4-Orange Spherical 4 -Yellow Cylindrical 1-Green Tetrahedron

## **9. THE START**

- 9.1. Races will be started using RRS 26 with the warning signal given 5 minutes before the starting signal. The starting signal for one class will be coincident with the warning signal for the next.
- 9.2. Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area.

## **10. INDIVIDUAL RECALLS**

Individual Recalls will be signaled in accordance with RRS rule 29.1. In addition, the committee will attempt to hail the sail number of the offending boat(s). Failure of the over-early boat(s) to hear such notification, or the committee's failure to hail, will not be grounds for redress.

## **11. THE FINISH**

The finish line will be between a blue flag on a RC Boat and nearby Green Tetrahedron Buoy.

## **12. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS**

Protests will be heard July 5<sup>th</sup> at 1500 Hour at the South Sail Folding Area. Shade will not be provided.

## **13. SCORING:**

The low point scoring system, Appendix A of RRS will be used except no score will be excluded. One race constitutes a regatta. Points will be award to those who decorate their boat or wear patriotic clothing.

#### **14. CHECK-IN**

Prior to the warning signal of the first race of the day, each boat shall sail past the race committee boat and hail her sail number until acknowledged by a member of the race committee. Check in will not commence until the Signal Boat displays the "L" Flag.
