Event: The Corinthian Sailing Club (OA) cordially invites you to a one-day, open regatta for all centerboard boats and the Corinthian Class Keel Boat.

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.

Entry: Registration may be completed online at www.cscsailing.org. Registration may be completed online or at the regatta site at 441 E Lawther Drive, Dallas, TX 75218 (No Cash, only Credit Cards or Checks). Registration will be at the CSC Clubhouse day of the regatta, opens at 9:00 AM and is closed at 10:00 AM. Sailing Instructions will be available at check in and online. Because of COVID 19 guidelines we are only allowing 80 CSC participants. Non CSC members will be allowed but CSC members will get priority over nonmembers.

Regatta Plan: The State Fair Regatta is a one-day regatta with three races planned. Three or more boats will race as a class. Boats that do not form a one design class will be assigned to a Portsmouth handicap class. One race constitutes a regatta.

Fees: Double handed boats online or at registration\$35.00
NOTE: Includes Corinthians

Single handed boats online or at registration..... \$30.00

NO MEALS will be provided, post-race snacks and refreshments will be provided.

Courses: Two course are planned and may overlap each other. The courses to be sailed are those specified in the Corinthian Sailing Club Sunday Joint Race Program Sailing Instructions.

- No Races after 17:00 Hours

Scoring: The low point scoring system, Appendix A of RRS will be used except no score will be excluded.

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to the top finishers in each class, depending on the number of boats registered.
